ADDIE: Design Model for signature Assignment

Learning Objectives (taken from the task analysis)

- 1. The learner can select correct definitions for the key vocabulary: phoneme, phonics, grapheme, digraph, trigraph, blend, segment, exception words. (Task 3)
- 2. The learner can identify the number of phonemes in a spoken word. (Task 1)
- 3.. The learner can select and adapt an activity that would help a child practise a phonemegrapheme pair. (Task 2)

Assessment Methods:

- 1. Online test multiple choice answers. Pass rate 80%. Learners will receive immediate feedback on completion of the test and can retake the test. Taking this test at the beginning and ending of the module would be a way to evaluate whether learning is taking place.
- 2. Online test with 10 questions. For each question: listen to a spoken word and count the number of phonemes. Pass rate 80%. Learners will receive immediate feedback on completion of the test and can retake the test with randomized new words.
- 3. Complete a siumulation:
 - Selecting an activity that uses phonic skills
 - Adapting that activity to a child's phonic needs
 - Applying phonic skills correctly within the context of the game

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Assessment design takes into account the available time, absence or presence of formative facilitator and peer feedback and available technology for the session.

Assesment 3 attempts to utilise some of the criteria of a Performance Task according to the UbD model. It requires the learners to apply their learning to a real world scenario, to demonstrate empathy with the child who would take part in the activity and it offers opportunity to gain self knowledge through further feedback within the scenario.

Learner Feedback Mechanisms:

Entry and exit survey online

Branching scenario offers realistic outcomes to decisions and relevant further feedback.

Instant learner feedback on online quizzes (assessments 1 &2)
